



Denman Island Baroque Music Workshop April 28 – May 4, 2024 Application Form

General Information for Workshop Applicants

The workshop is designed for experienced amateur and student musicians with an interest in baroque music. This will be the sixth edition after successful workshops on Purcell's *Dido & Aeneas* (2017), on Monteverdi's *L'Orfeo* (2018), on Purcell's *The Fairy Queen* (2019), on Blow's *Venus & Adonis* (2022) and on Monteverdi *Il Ballo delle Ingrate* and madrigals (2023). Over a week, the 2024 workshop participants will put together a program of music by Jean-Baptiste Lully (1632-1687), court composer to Louis XIV in Versailles. The music will feature extracts from the ballet *Le Triomphe de L'amour* and the pastoral (mini-opera) *La Grotte de Versailles*. There will be concurrent workshops for recorder players with Romeo Ciuffa and for strings with Paul Luchkow. The program will be under the musical direction of the world-renowned baroque harpsichordist and composer Marco Vitale. In rehearsals, he will be assisted by Romeo (winds tutor), Paul Luchkow (strings tutor) and tenor Marcel Beekman (voice tutor).

- The final performance will be in the Denman Island Community Hall in the afternoon of Saturday May 4, and will be semi-staged with costumes for singers and a stage set.
- Around 20-25 participants will play/sing in early baroque style and in a pitch of A = 415 Hz.
- String players may use baroque or modern instruments which should be fitted with gut strings and preferably played with a baroque bow.
- Wind players must play A=415 Hz instruments.
- Singers may opt to sing only in the chorus. Solo singers should be prepared to sing in the chorus when possible.
- Singers must be able to read music and preferably have had training and some experience in singing in small choirs. They must be able to sing in tune and preferably have a voice which carries.
- All participants are expected to attend all rehearsals.
- A healthy lunch will be provided to all participants.
- Off-island participants will be billeted near the practice venues with Denman residents and will be provided dinners prepared by local caterers, including complementary wine.
- Contrasto Armonico (the instructors) will perform a concert during the week.
- There will be a Friday concert for workshop participants and tutors
- There will be a welcome reception on the evening of April 28.
- There will also be a variety of other activities.

New applicants should enter information on their experience on the form so that a fair decision can be made if there is an excess of applicants to places for a part. We will try our best to accommodate all qualified applicants but a few may be disappointed. We look forward to receiving your applications and are happy to answer questions.

Fee payment

Full fee (including workshop, billet accommodation and meals): \$895 CAN Fee for participants who find own accommodation (includes meals): \$595 CAN Fee for local residents living at home (fee includes lunch): \$395 CAN Local participants are expected to attend all rehearsals.

Fees include local transportation on Denman Island, when needed, and admittance to all festival events, and are payable on acceptance to the workshop in January 2023. Details on payment methods will be provided at that time.

If applications for a part exceed our needs, selection will be on the basis of known ability/reported experience. Where such decisions are not clear, date of application will be considered. In exceptional circumstances, spots will be allocated before January 1, 2024. The final decisions on acceptance of applications will be made by the musical director (Marco Vitale) by January 1, 2024. Successful applicants will be given details on the payment of fees at that time. If the workshop is cancelled, any paid fees will be fully refunded. Fifty percent of fees will be refunded on individual cancellations made on or before March 31, 2024. No refunds will be made to individuals cancelling after that date.

Student Scholarships

There will be a small number of scholarships for talented, full-time students, both singers and instrumentalists. Scholarship recipients will not pay fees, only transport to Denman Island. To apply for a scholarship, please fill in this form, indicate your education institution and send a letter of recommendation from a professor/teacher at your institution. Any donations to help in funding scholarships are welcome (cheques payable to Arts Denman with note Baroque workshop scholarships).
